FINAL FEASIBILITY REPORT AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE CAÑO MARTÍN PEÑA ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION PROJECT

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1970 (NEPA, PL 91-190), as amended, and Regulations of the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), this public notice constitutes a Notification of Availability of the Final Feasibility Report and Environmental Impact Statement for the Caño Martín Peña Ecosystem Restoration Project, San Juan, Puerto Rico (Final FR/EIS). The Final FR/EIS examines the benefits and effects of the Caño Martín Peña Ecosystem Restoration Project, which main objective is to re-establish the tidal connection between the San José Lagoon and the San Juan Bay through the dredging and channelization of approximately 2.2 miles of the eastern portion of the Caño Martín Peña.
